Morning visit to the legendary Stags Leap Cellars, famous for their great Cabernets, all of their wines are impressive. We will lunch in their private cellar room (*see below*).

In the afternoon we will visit Harlan Estate. Their vision.. to produce California 1st Growth from the hills of Oakville. Harlan are never open to the public, their wines sold by mail order only. FREE evening

Saturday 6th May (Day 7)

We visit California's revered 1st Growth producer Opus One, jointly owned by Chateau Mouton Rothschild and the Mondavi family. We will lunch at the winery or nearby, TBA. Enjoy a FREE afternoon, later that evening we come together for a group dinner in Napa.



Sunday 7th May (Day 8)

We move our residence from the Napa to Healdsburg to the gorgeous Les Mars Hotel. It's only an hours drive, you'll then be FREE to explore the town and we'll provide you with some tips on things to do there and places to eat.




Monday 8th May (Day 9)

Morning visit to Kuleto Winery and estate located in the mountains of Eastern Napa overlooking Lake Rutherford. 82 different vineyard blocks with 3 succinctly different soil types, the wines are stunning. Lunch at the winery or nearby TBA. FREE rest of afternoon. Group dinner later that night.



Tuesday 9th May (Day 10)

Morning visit to the premium estate Chalk Hill, a diverse mix of micro-climates/soils/exposures/elevations – the wines speak of their unique terroir. We will enjoy a leisurely lunch at the estate then head back to Healdsburg for a FREE rest of afternoon/evening.



Wednesday 10th May (Day 11)

Morning visit to Eisele Vineyards... under the same ownership (*François Pinault*) as the legendary Bordeaux 1st Growth producer, Chateau Latour. The Estate was first planted in 1880's and became biodynamically certified in 2000. It is one of the most elite estates in California.

We will lunch at the vineyard or nearby. That night we will stay in Santa Rosa (*close to airport for next day*) and have a group dinner.



Thursday 11th May (Day 12)

We fly to Portland (*approximately 1 hour 40 flight*) where we will have a group lunch then meet up with our coach to travel (*1-hour*) to our hotel in the famous Willamette Valley. You have a FREE evening.



Friday 12th May (Day 13)

Two great Oregon vineyard visits today - Lemelson Vineyards objective is to make some of the world's finest Pinot Noir, their vineyards are organic and their winery gravity designed. We will have lunch at the winery or nearby TBA.

In the afternoon we will visit Bergstrom whose elevated, rolling, sustainably managed vineyards enable them to make some of the regions finest wines. We will enjoy a group dinner that evening TBA.


Saturday 13th May (Day 14)
